A reminder to parents in Mataweka Hub that Class Camps are getting closer. **Full Camp fees** are **NOW** due for payment. In the first week of December when Camp finances have been finalised those that have attended Camp will receive a refund for their share of fundraising. For example if 85 students attend Camp and the fundraising total is \$2500 each student would receive a refund of \$29.40. Camp fees are as follows: **Rm 12 \$130, Rm 1 \$140, Rm 2 \$160 and Rm 3 \$80.** If there are two children from the same family in the same class then the first child pays full price and the second child pays half price.
