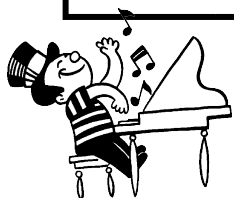

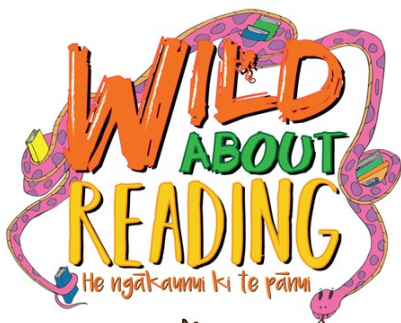
WEETBIX TRYATHLON 2018 - WEDNESDAY 14 FEBRUARY
